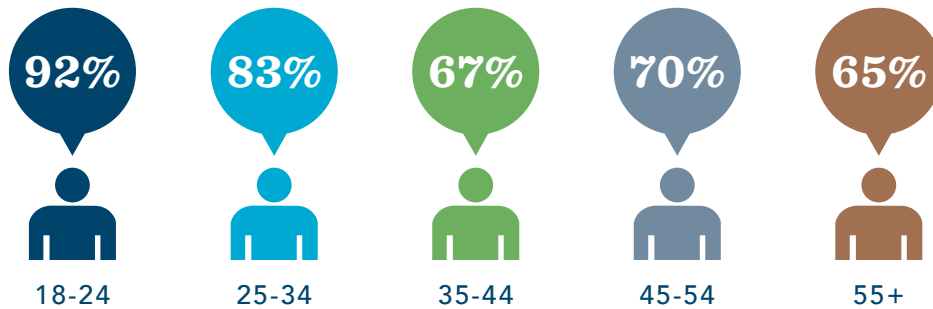


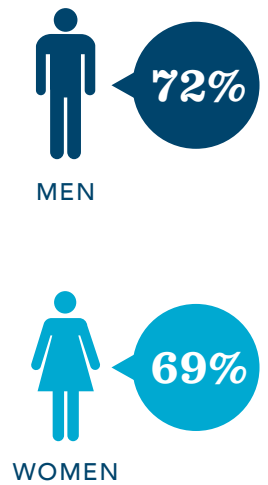
7 in 10 Virginians Support Medical Aid in Dying

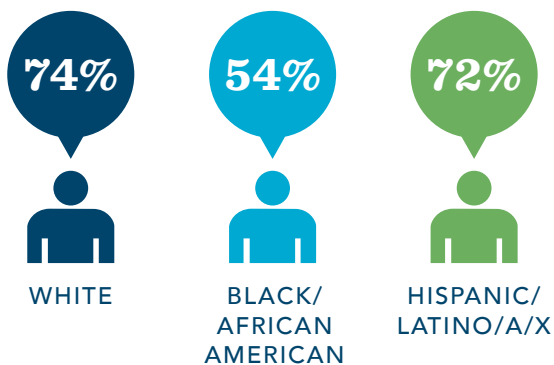

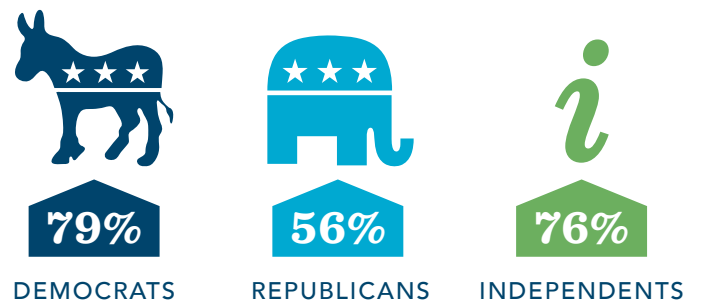
GENDER



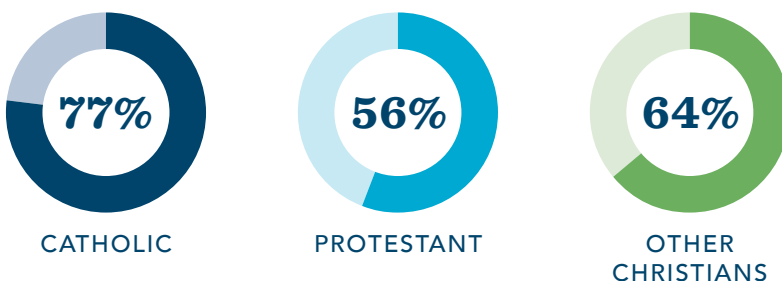
RACE/ETHNICITY
