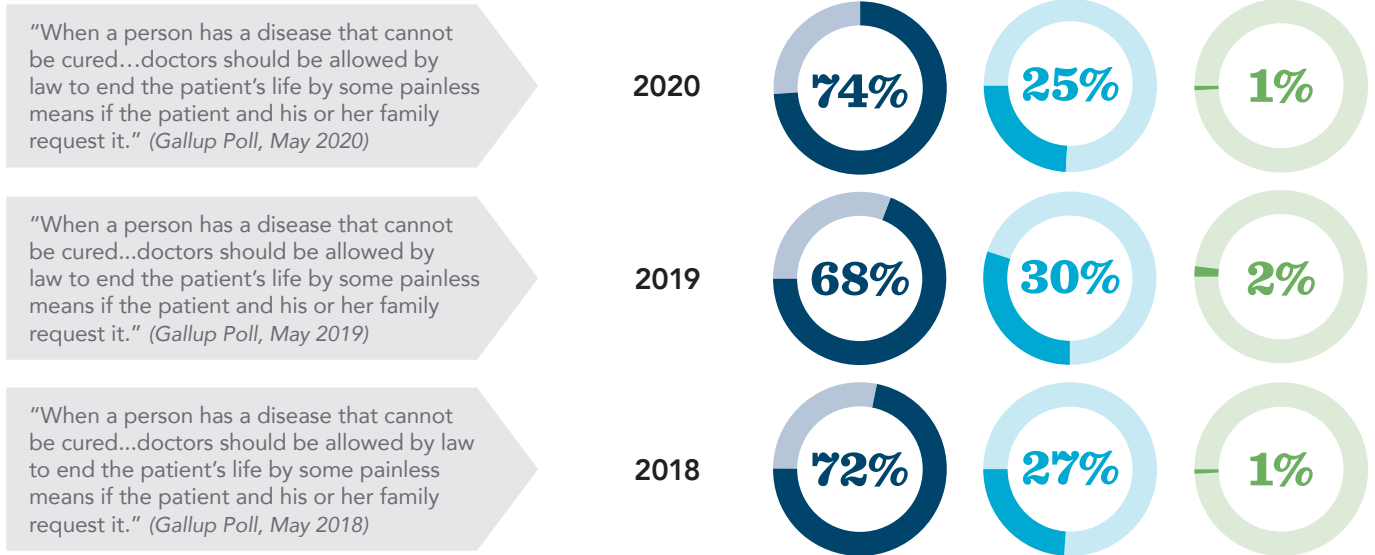


Most Americans Support Medical Aid in Dying

SUPPORT ACROSS DIFFERENT RACES



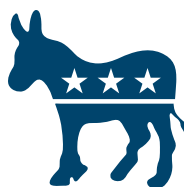
SUPPORT ACROSS DIFFERENT AGE GROUPS



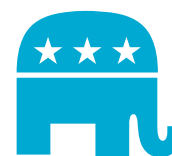
SUPPORT ACROSS DIFFERENT POLITICAL AFFILIATIONS

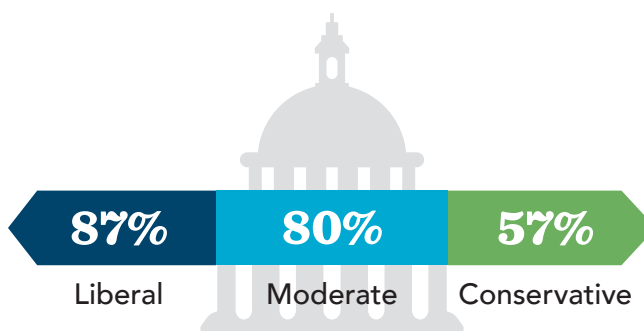

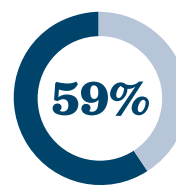
SUPPORT ACROSS MULTIPLE RELIGIOUS AFFILIATIONS

"When a person is facing a terminal disease, it is morally acceptable to ask for a physician's aid in taking his or her own life." (LifeWay Research, September-October 2016)

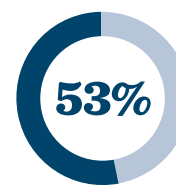

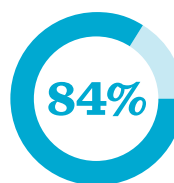
