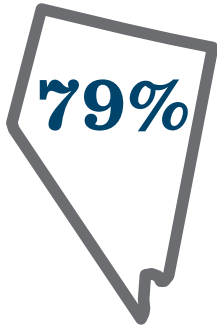


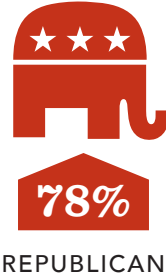
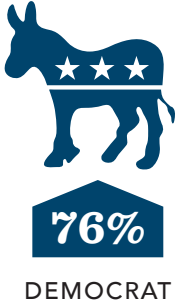
# 8 out of 10 Nevadans Support Medical Aid in Dying

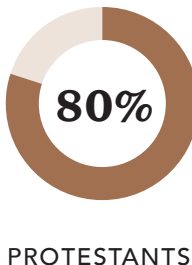
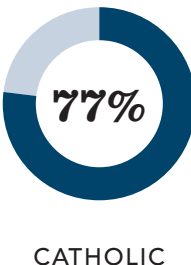
